

### Police Department Personnel



With the Town of Jupiter experiencing rapid growth and development, there will be associated traffic and public safety issues which will place additional demands upon the Police Department. This year, Town Council approved to civilianize functions within the police department that were being performed by sworn personnel. This allowed for additional officers to be placed on the road in order to continue our vision of maintaining safe and secure neighborhoods.

### Accreditation



The Jupiter Police Department maintains status as an accredited agency through both the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA) and the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation (CFA). The agency initially became accredited through CFA in June of 2000, and was subsequently reaccredited in 2004, 2007, 2010 and 2013. The agency first earned accreditation with CALEA in 2004, with reaccreditations in 2007, 2010 and 2013.

# JUPITER POLICE DEPARTMENT 2014 CRIME STATISTICS

The Jupiter Police Department utilizes comprehensive geographic information system (GIS) technology to monitor and track crimes occurring in the town. In turn, the department and residents are better informed with relevant information on crime patterns and trends, allowing for timely use and reallocation of personnel and resources to prevent crime and apprehend criminals.







9 YEARS OF SERVICE


DECEMBER 5, 2005 – DECEMBER 25, 2014


